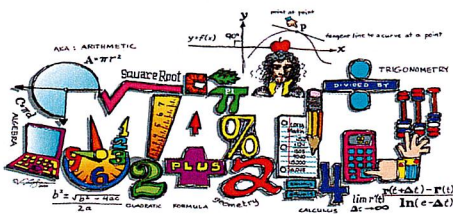
As winter weather approaches, please remember that if there is a 2hr delay, doors will open at 9:30 a.m. and the tardy bell rings at 9:50 a.m.

Transportation Notes

Please plan ahead. We have 595 students and are experiencing a high volume of calls during the day to change transportation plans. If your child will be going home a different way at the end of the day, please send a note with your child that morning in their backpack. **DO NOT** email the teacher. The office is the hub for all transportation notes and at the end of the day if we are asked and we have not been told about a change we will go by what their normal is. Please make sure their Name (first and last), teacher name, date, parent's signature and what they are doing is on the note. We are getting notes with first names only and no teacher or signature which makes it hard to decipher. We are attaching a sheet of transportation notes to the newsletter that you may make copies of and cut apart and use for this purpose. **In an emergency**, you may call the office to request a note be sent to your child.

NOTE: We are asking that you put your child's car seat in the back seat on the right side behind the passenger seat so that children do not have to walk around the car.
